What is Child Protection about?

- All of the adults around you think that your health, safety and happiness are very important.
- In our school, we respect children and help to protect their rights.
- We do our best to help <u>all</u> children learn and improve.
- We teach you how to recognise risks in different situations, and how to protect yourself and stay safe.

How will we try to protect children?

- We give a safe school for children to learn in;
- We want to help you to remain safe, at home as well as at school;
- We think it is important for you to know where to get help if you are worried or unhappy about something.

Don't keep it a secret if:

- Someone is being unkind or bullying you;
- Saying funny things to you that you do not like or upsets you;
- Touching you in places you know are private



- Trying to give you tablets, cigarettes, vapes, drugs or alcohol;
- Hitting you or hurting you;
- Sending unkind messages or private pictures on the internet, to your phone or on a games console.
